The purpose of the Private Satellite Program is to offer community homeschool families an array of educational opportunities for students in grades Kindergarten through 6th grade within a Christian setting. The CCLS-PSP operates under the provision of the California Education Code Section 48222, falling under the Private School Affidavit of Cross and Crown Lutheran School, which is filed annually each October.

Enrollment

- Enrollment is open to students who are at least 5 years old by September 1 of the current year.
- Annual membership in Home School Legal Defense Association is mandatory as a means of protection and support. **Group discount #21037.**

Fees

Registration Fee \$175/family
Materials Fee \$35 per child

Home School Legal Defense Membership save \$15 with group discount (#21037)

Tuition - 9 monthly payments of \$45 \$405/year for one child
9 monthly payments of \$55 \$495/year for two students
9 monthly payments of \$65 \$585/year for three or more students

Tuition includes enrollment in up to three on-campus classes per trimester. Tuition does not include Art class materials, field trip, or daycare fees. Monthly tuition payments are due by the 1st of each month, September through May.
